### *Symposium: American Gothic*



In celebration of the exhibition *Gothic Art in the Gilded Age: Medieval and Renaissance Treasures in the Gavet-Vanderbilt-Ringling Collection* and its catalogue publication *Gothic Art in the Gilded Age*, The Ringling Museum will host a symposium focusing on the theme of collecting and display of medieval and Renaissance art in Europe and America in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. This symposium will be a gathering of American and foreign scholars from the Musée du Louvre, the Victoria & Albert Museum, the Cleveland Museum of Art, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Hearst Castle, the Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum, and The Preservation Society of Newport County.

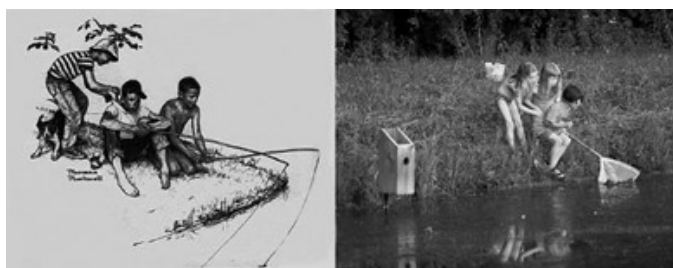
### Gothic Art in the Gilded Age

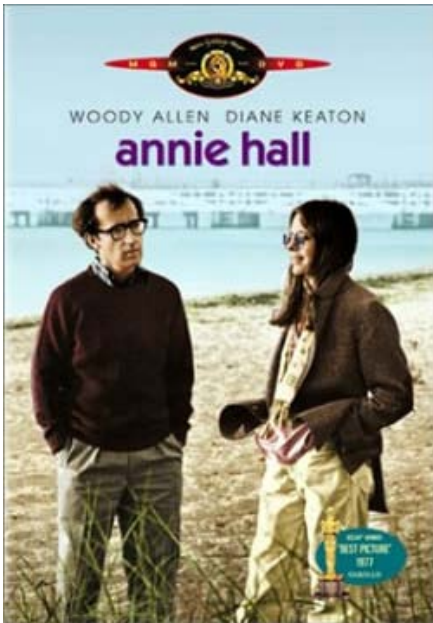


