Foreword



THE School of Art of the John and Mable Ringling Art Museum, which will open at Sarasota, Florida, October 1, 1931, was founded March 31, 1931, through the generosity of John Ringling.

Besides courses in art under famous instructors whose works have already won recognition, the curriculum of the institution will include a two-year college course leading to Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Arts degrees.

Both the School of Art and the Junior College department will be operated under the control of Southern College, Lakeland, Florida.

In the School of Art, the student may take courses in both applied and fine art. The Junior College courses will include the standard variety of foundation subjects.

It will be the purpose of the School to do more than develop artistic talent and provide intellectual training; its purpose will include the fullest development of personality, also, in order to assist each student to a happy adjustment to the circumstances of the world in which he finds himself.

The first aim of the School, therefore, will be to provide individual education for the individual student.
